Rules and Conditions

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1. Please note that completion of the 2017 Gait To Success Application form does not necessarily mean you will be chosen to participate in the clinic. All applications are reviewed by the Rider Selection Committee and clinician to select the best matches based on session availability and the mission statement of the clinic.
2. Any horses causing a problem and being a danger to itself, or other animals or persons must be removed.
3. An approved safety helmet must be worn at all times while mounted.
4. Clinic participants should wear appropriate clothing. Show clothing is not required but we ask that all clothing and equipment be clean and in good condition to show the appropriate respect to the clinician.
5. All stalls will be assigned. Stall changes will not be permitted.
6. The Alberta Equestrian Federation nor Horse in Hand Ranch accepts any responsibility for lost or stolen items. All items including horses, tack, equipment, vehicles, trailers are left at your own risk.
7. Riders/handlers are responsible for providing additional bedding and necessary feed. Two bags of shavings are provided by Horse in Hand Ranch for each stall. Riders/handlers are also responsible for the cleaning of stalls.
8. The rider/horse check-in will be open Thursday, April 27, 2017 for Dressage Riders only from 4pm - 8pm. Rider/horse check-in for Jumper Riders will be open from 4 pm - 8 pm Saturday, April 30, 2017. If you are arriving earlier or later, you MUST ensure that you contact our office so arrangements can be made.
9. A signed "Acknowledgment of Risk" and "Release of Liability" waivers are required. If you are under 18 years of age your parent or guardian will be required to sign these forms. If your parent or guardian is not traveling with you please contact our office so forms can be sent out ahead of time.
10. Riders are allowed to be accompanied by a parent and their coach to the "Meet and Greet" for no additional charge. During the clinic, a parent and the coach of the rider have complimentary access; a \$20 per day fee will apply for lunch.
11. You are responsible for being at the venue and in the ring at your scheduled time; there will be no delays or refunds for late participants. Schedule to be released no later than April 13, 2017.
12. Cancellation is required at least 48 hours in advance and a refund will only be issued with a doctor's or veterinarian's certificate received prior to the 48 hour cut-off.
13. No dogs are allowed on the property.
