This is a working facility and bathroom facilities are limited to outhouses.

Spots Available:

Spots are very limited in order to give participants a very hands-on experience. Participants will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis, upon payment in full.

Cost: \$80 (includes GST)

The registration fee includes: two (2) full day of learning how to drive (targeted at those individuals with limited to no experience), all materials, breakfast, tea/coffee, lunch and snacks. Demo and practice horses will be provided and participants will not be allowed to bring their own horses.
