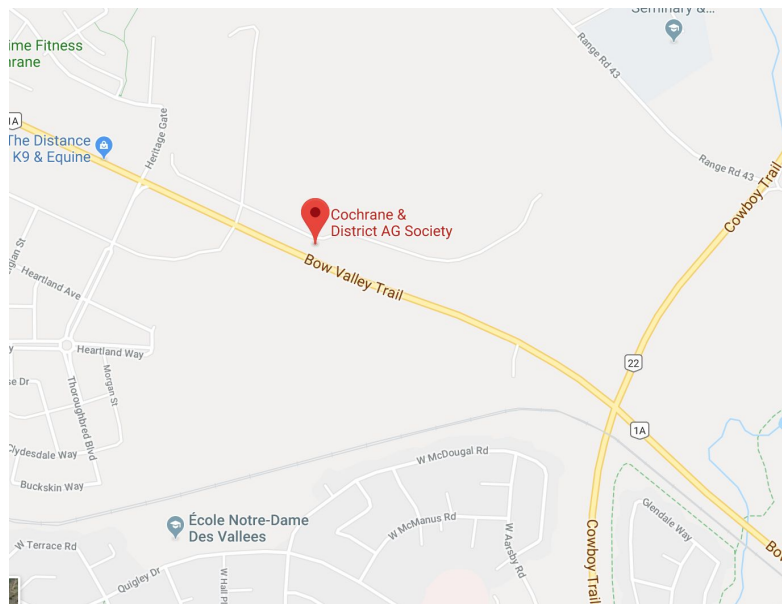

The show grounds are located on the North West side of Cochrane. Access to the grounds is located on Hwy 1A, heading west from Cochrane, turn at the first exit on the right. The road does a U-turn up to the show grounds.



Clinic – Thursday July 11

A Working Equitation clinic on Thursday, July 11 2019 with Rebecca Algar in conjunction with the show event.

Fee is \$150.00 per rider for 2.0-hour ride with a maximum of 4 riders per class.

WECAN & B Pony Club members receive a \$20.00 discount on the clinic.

Location is at the Cochrane & District Agricultural Society Showgrounds.

Space is limited.

Event Format

- Thursday: July 11: Working Equitation Clinic will start at 8:00 am
- Friday: July 12: Dressage for all levels
 - Ease of Handling for Introductory if time allows
- Saturday: July 13: Ease of Handling for All levels
 - Speed: Advanced Level
 - *Ribbons Ceremony for Introductory & Advance Levels*
- Sunday: July 14: Speed Novice & Intermediate
 - *Ribbon Ceremony for Novice & Invoice*

Results: Scores used in B-rated competitions result in points earned toward required advancement. Scores earned at B-rated competitions are used to determine eligibility for national championship competitions.

Competition Rules

Ride in The West is sanctioned as Alberta Wild Rose Competition with Alberta Equestrian Federation and Working Equitation Canada (WECAN) as a Working Equitation Show. This competition will use the Working Equitation Canada 2018 Rules. The rules and 2018 Dressage test (Functionality test) can be found on the WECAN.

The electronic version will take precedence over any printed version.

Entries:

- A horse/rider pair is considered an entry.
- A horse/rider entry may only compete in one level per show.
- At “B” Rated shows, a horse may be ridden a maximum of twice with different riders and the riders must be in different levels.
- Riders under 18 years of age must have permission to ride in the competition as indicated by a signature of their parent or guardian.

Tack & Attire are in the WECAN rules.

- Any tradition or discipline of tack is allowed within the confinement of the WECAN rules.
- Mandatory wear of approved helmet
- Riders wanting to wear alternate headgear such as a cowboy hat must sign a waiver at the show office before doing so.

Horse Requirements:

- Any horse, with the exception of miniature horses is eligible to compete.
- All horses entered must be serviceably sound; show no signs of lameness, discomfort, or pain; and be in good condition.
- A horse must be at least 4 years old at the beginning of the competition year to compete in the Children, Introductory (L1), and Novice A/B (L2/L3) levels.
- A horse must be at least 5 years old at the beginning of the competition year to compete in the Intermediate A/B (L4/L5) levels.
- A horse must be at least 6 years old at the beginning of the competition year to compete in the Advanced (L6) and Masters (L7) levels.

Membership:

1. All riders and horse owners are required to have an AEF Membership or provincial affiliation club membership.

3. A non-member fee for \$25.00 is available for the weekend.

Facility Rules

Dogs must be on a short non retractable leash and well behaved.

Garbage & Recycle Cans are provided.

Port-a-potties are located on site

Cochrane Agricultural District Society Show Ground Rules of Conduct are posted throughout the facility and show grounds.

Safety Concerns must be brought to the Ag Society Office.

Stabling

- In-door stalls are available onsite from Thursday July 11-14.
- Cost is \$35.00 (plus GST) per night plus \$35.00 deposit. Horses are to only use the stalls assigned to them. If you want to be stabled with another rider or stable, state your request on your show entry form or email; wec.cochrane@gmail.com in the subject line on your email type "Stable Request".
- Stalls must be stripped clean at the end of the show. You can clean your stall yourself or forfeit your deposit : Donate to the Cochrane Pony Club ; who will clean your stall and benefit from your donation..
- This must be indicated on your show entry.
- **Water:** potable water is trucked into the show grounds for horses. Transfer buckets are provided.

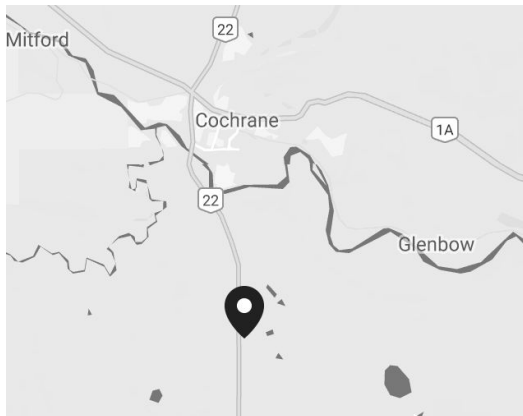
Saturday July 13 – Sponsored Food truck will be on site.
