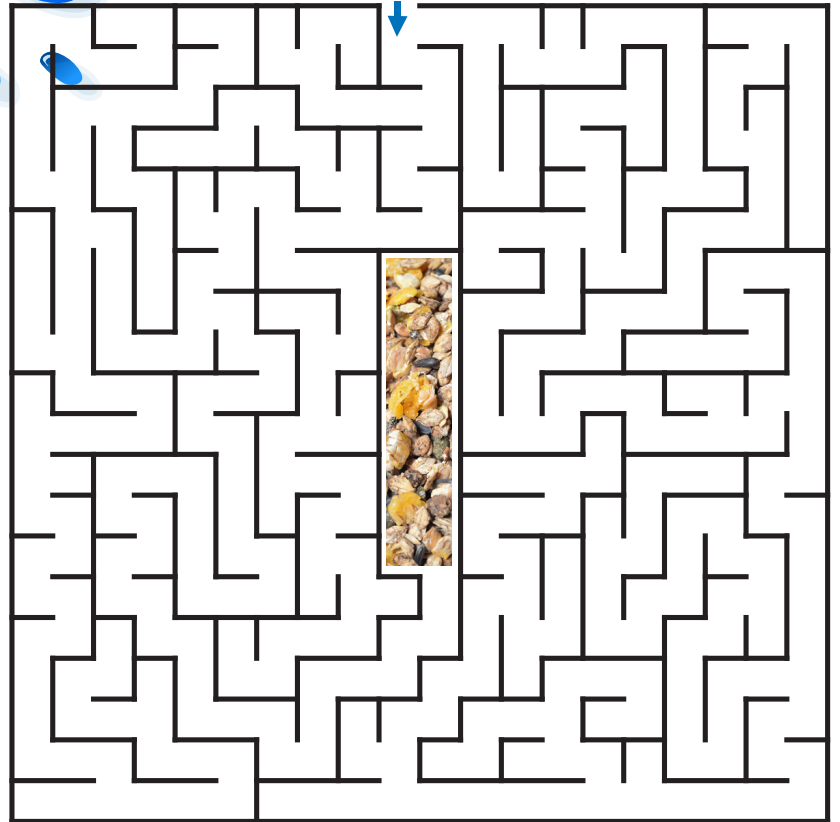

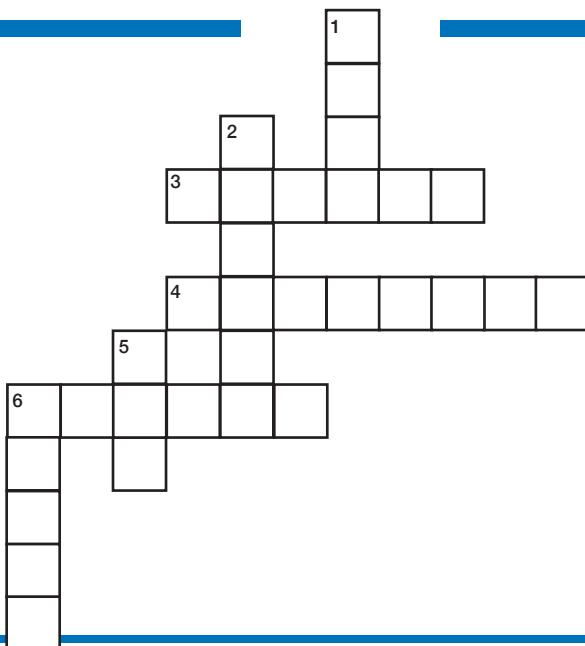


It's time for these geldings to come in from the pasture and eat their feed. Can you help them find their way through the maze?
