

Whom May Examine English Rider Levels

English Rider Level 1-2 Examiners

- Must be an NCCP Equestrian Canada current certified Instructor or Coach who is trained to examine the rider levels;
- May be examined by own NCCP Equestrian Canada current certified Instructor or Coach who is trained to examine the rider levels;
- May be examined by a single examiner.

English Rider Level 3-4 Examiners

- Must be an NCCP Equestrian Canada current certified Coach who is trained to examine the rider levels;
- May be examined by own NCCP Equestrian Canada current certified Coach who is trained to examine the rider levels;
- May be examined by current *Instructor with Jump Module (if not their own students)* who is trained to examine the rider levels;
- Note: If candidates are NOT doing the Jump Module, then a current Instructor without the jump module may examine (not their own students);
- May be examined by a single examiner.

English Rider Level 5 Examiners

- Must be an NCCP Equestrian Canada current certified Coach who is trained to examine the rider levels;
- Examiners may not examine their own students;
- May be examined by a single examiner.

English Rider Level 6-7-8 Examiners

- Must be an NCCP Equestrian Canada current certified Coach who is trained to examine the rider levels;
- Examiners may not examine their own students;
- May be examined by a single examiner.

English Rider 9-10 Examiners

- Must be an NCCP Equestrian Canada current certified Competition Coach Specialist or High Performance Coach, one of which to be discipline specific according to elective of candidate;
- Must be examined by two examiner.

Important: All Examiners must have attended a specialized training event to become an approved examiner by the Alberta Equestrian Federation.
