

NCCP English Instructor/Competition Coach Certification Prerequisites of English Learn to Ride Program

The following outlines the necessary English Learn to Ride levels that are required as a prerequisite for candidates looking to become NCCP Certified English Instructors or Competition Coaches.

English Instructor Prerequisite

A rider looking to become an NCCP Certified English Equestrian Instructor is required to complete the following English Learn to Ride levels/sections as a prerequisite:

- English Instructor Flat –
 - Minimum English Rider Level 6 (Current Programming) Flat Only Sections;
 - Pony Club Level “C2”
 - English Learn to Ride Level 2 (Old Programming)
 - Physical Exemption and completion of Stable Management and Written Test Sections of all levels up to and including Level 6 (Current Programming)
- English Instructor Jump –
 - Minimum English Rider Level 6 with Jump Sections (Current Programming);
 - Pony Club Level “C2”
 - English Learn to Ride Level 2 (Old Programming)
 - Physical Exemption and completion of Stable Management and Written Test Sections of all levels up to and including Level 6 (Current Programming)

English Competition Coach Prerequisite

A rider looking to become an NCCP Certified English Equestrian Competition Coach is required to complete the following English Learn to Ride levels/sections as a prerequisite:

- English Competition Coach—
 - Minimum English Rider Level 8 (Current Programming) All Test Sections including Jumping;
 - Pony Club Level “B” or “A”
 - English Learn to Ride Level 3 (Old Programming)
 - Physical Exemption and completion of Stable Management and Written Test Sections of all levels up to and including Level 8 (Current Programming)
