

## **English Learn to Ride Program Exemptions/Equivalencies**

The following explanations outline the available exemptions and equivalencies that are in place for the English Learn to Ride Program.

### **Physical/Medical Exemption**

Instructor/Coach candidates using the English Learn to Ride Program as a prerequisite, but for physical reasons are no longer capable of riding, may apply for exemption from the riding portion of Rider Level 6 or 8 by contacting the AEF and by filling out the AEF Learn to Ride Physical Exemption Request Form. **IMPORTANT:** Candidates applying for an exemption must provide supporting evidences of knowledge of riding skills at these levels, as well as professional references. Official medical documentation from a physician is required as supporting evidence as well. Riders will be required to still complete the stable management and written sections of the Learn to Ride levels. Certificates and badges are not issued in this instance.

### **Granting Equivalency**

An individual who has obtained the Canadian Pony Club “C2” will be recognized as equivalent to Rider 6 in the English Learn to Ride Program. An individual who has obtained the Canadian Pony Club “B” or “A” will be recognized as equivalent to Rider 8 in the English Learn to Ride Program. **IMPORTANT:** Official documentation, with the candidate's name and proper credentials clearly outlined, must accompany the AEF English Learn to Ride Pony Club Equivalency Application form.
