

## **Western Learn to Ride Program Exemptions/Equivalencies**

The following explanations outline the available exemptions and equivalencies that are in place for the Western Learn to Ride Program.

### **Physical/Medical Exemption**

Instructor/Coach candidates using the Western Learn to Ride Program as a prerequisite, but for physical reasons are no longer capable of riding, may apply for exemption from the riding portion of Rider Level 4 or the Western Intermediate Rider levels by contacting the AEF and by filling out the AEF Learn to Ride Physical Exemption Request Form. **IMPORTANT:** Candidates applying for an exemption must provide supporting evidences of knowledge of riding skills at these levels, as well as professional references. Official medical documentation from a physician is required as supporting evidence as well. Riders will be required to still complete the stable management and written sections of the Learn to Ride levels. Certificates and badges are not issued in this instance.

### **Granting Equivalence**

Currently there are no equivalencies for the Western Learn to Ride program.
